

Official Notice of Election for Military and Overseas Voters
County of Franklin
2026 General Primary
May 19, 2026

This is an official notice of a Primary Election to be conducted on May 19, 2026, in Franklin County. You may register to vote and request an official absentee ballot by using the Federal Postcard Application (FPCA), available at www.vote.pa.gov or www.fvap.gov. You may apply for an absentee ballot by submitting your FPCA by fax to (717) 261-3131, or by email to voter@franklincountypa.gov.

You may request an absentee ballot from this office at any time prior to a primary or election. However, if time does not permit you to receive and return an official absentee ballot, you are also entitled to vote using the Federal Write-in Absentee Ballot (FWAB). Military electors may also use the FWAB to register to vote and vote simultaneously.

You may use the FWAB to vote for **all** federal, state, and local offices, and ballot initiatives.

To vote, fill out and send in the **Voter Information Page** (page 2) and **Official Backup Ballot** (page 3) of the FWAB.

To vote for offices or for ballot initiatives, write the names of candidates or ballot initiatives in the appropriate section of the FWAB. Under the **Federal Offices** heading, enter the name or political party of the federal candidate you choose. Under the **Other Offices** heading, enter the state or local office, name of candidate or political party of the candidate you choose. Under the **Ballot Initiative or other items** heading, enter the title of the ballot initiative (referendum) you are voting on and write “yes” or “no.”

NOTE: THIS NOTICE WILL BE UPDATED WITH THE NAMES OF CANDIDATES WHEN THEY BECOME AVAILABLE.

THE NOTICE MUST BE CONSULTED REGULARLY BECAUSE OF THE POSSIBILITY THAT CANDIDATE LISTS MAY CHANGE.

Representative in Congress (Vote for ONE) – All Precincts in Franklin County

Representative in the Pennsylvania General Assembly from the 81st Legislative District - Vote for ONE – Fannett Township, Letterkenny Township, Lurgan Township, Metal Township, Orrstown Borough, Southampton Township, St. Thomas Township, and West End Shippensburg Borough

Representative in the Pennsylvania General Assembly from the 89th Legislative District - Vote for ONE – Chambersburg Borough, Greene Township, Guilford Township, and Hamilton Township

Representative in the Pennsylvania General Assembly from the 90th Legislative District - Vote for ONE – Antrim Township, Greencastle Borough, Mercersburg Borough, Mont Alto Borough, Montgomery Township, Peters Township, Quincy Township, Warren Township, Washington Township, and Waynesboro Borough

Member of Democratic State Committee - Vote for NOT MORE THAN TWO (The female and the male with the highest number of votes shall be elected) - All Precincts in Franklin County

Committeeman - Vote for ONE – All Precincts in Franklin County

Committeewoman - Vote for ONE – All Precincts in Franklin County

REPUBLICAN BALLOT

Governor - Vote for ONE – All Precincts in Franklin County

Lieutenant Governor - Vote for ONE – All Precincts in Franklin County

Representative in Congress (Vote for ONE) – All Precincts in Franklin County

Representative in the Pennsylvania General Assembly from the 81st Legislative District - Vote for ONE – Fannett Township, Letterkenny Township, Lurgan Township, Metal Township, Orrstown Borough, Southampton Township, St. Thomas Township, and West End Shippensburg Borough

Representative in the Pennsylvania General Assembly from the 89th Legislative District - Vote for ONE – Chambersburg Borough, Greene Township, Guilford Township, and Hamilton Township

Representative in the Pennsylvania General Assembly from the 90th Legislative District - Vote for ONE – Antrim Township, Greencastle Borough, Mercersburg Borough, Mont Alto Borough, Montgomery Township, Peters Township, Quincy Township, Warren Township, Washington Township, and Waynesboro Borough

Member of Republican State Committee - Vote for NOT MORE THAN SIX, 3 Males and 3 Females - All Precincts in Franklin County.

Committeeperson - Vote for NOT MORE THAN TWO – All Precincts in Franklin County
