Franklin County's Grants Management Department offers support and comprehensive services to county agencies and eligible local 501(c)(3) non-profit organizations to secure and manage grant funding. Our team works hand in hand with clients in researching, developing, applying for and managing grants to help ensure successful outcomes for all involved.



Available Services

Research

Staff continuously monitor federal, state and private grant announcements — both online and through published resources — to identify emerging grant opportunities. We maintain regular communication with funding agencies to ensure timely, accurate information. Relevant opportunities are sent directly to agencies via email.

Screening

Department staff review grant requirements to determine alignment with the applicant's program goals. We work together with the client to establish a realistic timeline and clarify application, approval, evaluation and award processes, especially when county government involvement is required.

Development

As the applicant prepares the proposal, staff serve as an active partner. We can participate in planning sessions, review draft materials and assist with background research to strengthen the client's application.

Management

After a grant is awarded, we collaborate with the Franklin County Fiscal Department and the relevant county agency to set up the grant within the county's financial management system. We also support agencies with progress reporting, data collection, analysis and general grant management and sustainability questions.
